CHRISTMAS HOLIDAYS

FRIDAY FOOD-Term 2

We will commence accepting applications for admission on 08/01/2025 and will cease accepting applications on 28/02/2025. Applicants will be notified of the decision on their application by 07/03/2025. Applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer no later than 28/03/2025.
